

Notice to Owners of Unclaimed Property

**The California State Controller is safeguarding cash, securities, and valuables for millions of individuals and businesses.
Could any belong to you?**



By law, businesses and institutions must hand over property such as bank accounts, uncashed checks, insurance benefits, stocks, savings bonds, and safe deposit box contents when there has been no account activity or owner contact, generally for three years. The State Controller's Office has unclaimed property for more than 93 million individuals and organizations.

Claims can be filed electronically. There is no deadline for claiming your property. Contact the State Controller's Office to get information concerning the amount or description of a property belonging to you.
