



Andrea Baumann (Feather)

June 6, 1955 – December 2, 2025

Andrea Baumann (Feather) DDS, MS, a former longtime Chino Valley resident, died of metastatic cancer at age 70 in Memphis, Tennessee on December 2, 2025.

Andrea was born in Seattle, Washington on June 6, 1955. She grew up in a busy home with her twin brother and three sisters. Both her parents were high school teachers. Family vacations were a regular

activity and music lessons filled the after-school hours. Andrea was a guitar teacher and music major before she made the decision to change her career path and become a dentist. She attended both Cal State LA and Cal State Fullerton, graduating from UCLA School of Dentistry and then UCLA's orthodontic program. She married Jeff Feather and had two daughters, Ashlynn and Lauren, while settling into their home in Chino Hills. Her daughters are graduates of Ontario Christian High School.

Andrea was a skilled and compassionate orthodontist who practiced in the Chino Valley for 25 years. Her primary interest was special needs children with cleft lip and cleft palate. She loved her work with children. An expert on the treatment of craniofacial abnormalities, Andrea was on the cleft lip and palate surgical teams of both Kaiser and CHOC and continued to provide essential care and treatment to infants and children after relocating to Memphis, Tennessee. Her career included practices in Arkansas, Tennessee, New Hampshire and North Carolina.

Andrea lectured annually at UCLA dental school. She worked with Western University of Health Sciences in Pomona to establish their orthodontic program. Andrea also formed a "study club" for local Chino Valley dentists. In her spare time, she enjoyed golf, cycling and beachcombing.

She is survived by her mother, Rosemarie Baumann of Chino Hills, her daughters, Lauren Magorian of Auburn California, and Ashlynn Ruman of Tehachapi, California; her infant granddaughter Kira Rose Ruman; her twin brother Christopher Baumann (Irvine), sisters Geneva Bridges (Chino), Rebecca Cockrum (Upland), and Maggie Baumann (Gig Harbor, Washington); her former husband Jeff Feather of Chino and numerous nephews and nieces.
