



Eulogio “Jack” M. Aguilar

Eulogio M. Aguilar, also known as “Jack,” 85, passed away on May 22, 2026, in Upland, California. He was born on September 12, 1940 in Eddy County, New Mexico, the son of Theodore and Fausta Aguilar.
