Kenneth McSpadden, devoted husband, father, grandfather, and friend to many passed away peacefully in his home on September 8, 2026 at the age of 93. Born in McCamey, Texas, he moved with his family to Southern California in his early teenage years. He had been a resident of Chino for over 65 years.



Kenneth served in the Navy from 1952 - 1955 and began his trade as an electrician when arriving home. Shortly thereafter, he married Rose Marie Marston and had two children, Ken McSpadden and Erin McSpadden-Dasher. Kenneth had a love for outdoor activities that included camping, trap and skeet shooting, and hunting and fishing. He was instrumental in the approval process and construction of the Pomona Valley Model Airplane Club's Prado flying site in Chino.
