Concepcion Sierra (Concho), 69, of Chino and Riverside California, passed away at home on November 2, 2025. He was born April 29, 1956, in San Antonio Texas and grew up in Chino, where he attended Chino High School. After marrying his wife, Sandra, in 1981, they made their home in Riverside.
