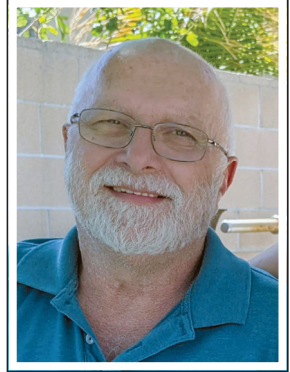


Andre Alfred Hasenbein

Andre Alfred Hasenbein passed away at home on May 2, 2026, surrounded by his loving family, in Chino Hills, California. He was born on July 17, 1955 in Edmonton, Alberta, Canada to his German parents, Franz “Alfred” and Ingetraut Hasenbein. He was one of two children. The family immigrated to the United States driving from Edmonton through the Sweet Grass, Montana point of entry in May of 1961. They drove to California and settled in Anaheim, California.
