Hire for Full-Time Police Officer

Accepting applications: **Thursday, May 5th - Wednesday, May 25th, 2022**

The Cadott Police Department is accepting applications for the purpose of hiring a full-time police officer. Village of Cadott full-time police officers will have a starting pay ranging from **\$21.57/hour to \$22.75/hour**, dependent on previous law enforcement experience, training and education. This position includes a benefits package.

Applicants must meet the following requirements: be a U.S. citizen with a valid WI driver's license; have an acceptable driver's record with no felony driving convictions; must be in good physical condition; must be eligible for certification by the Wisconsin Department of Justice-Law Enforcement Standards Board and have a minimum of 60-college credits or an associate degree or bachelors degree in Criminal Justice or related field and have completed a required recruit academy; have obtained a high school diploma; have a criminal history clear of felony convictions and the ability to possess a firearm; no domestic abuse convictions; vision correctable to 20/20; above average written and oral communication skills; **the ability to react quickly and effectively in stressful situations; the ability to work nights, weekends and holidays or otherwise as directed by the Chief of Police**; knowledge and skilled in operating computer systems; to be able to speak clearly and concisely; the ability to multi-task; the training and ability to perform essential job functions of the position and the ability to use all required law enforcement equipment correctly and effectively.

Applicants **must** submit a **typed** Department of Justice (DOJ-LE-330) application with optional cover letter and/or resume by the above deadline. A resume' is not an acceptable substitution for the required job application; but may be included with the application.

Selected applicants may need to pass a written exam, oral interview, psychological profile, medical and/or physical fitness tests, vision exam, drug screening and background investigation prior to a conditional offer of employment. Initial uniforms are provided and paid for by the Village of Cadott for full-time officers as well as an annual uniform allowance of up to \$450.00. Residency in or near the village is encouraged but is not required. Applicants with prior work-related experience are encouraged to apply.
