

# **CHIPPEWA COUNTY SEEKS COUNTY BOARD SUPERVISOR FOR DISTRICT 15**

Chippewa County is now accepting applications from individuals who desire to serve as a County Board Supervisor for District 15. The district consists of the Ward 1, City of Chippewa Falls, Town of Eagle Point excepting the area laying north of 145th Ave., continuing west as County Hwy Y, and then running north on State Hwy 124, then west on 155th Ave., to the town line, and also excepting the area laying to the east of County Hwy I and County Hwy S running north of Chippewa Falls and all of the Town of Eagle Point laying south of said areas. The term of this vacancy will run through April 2022.

The County Board meets monthly and is comprised of fifteen elected supervisors representing each of the districts in the County. The general powers of the County Board are provided under Wis. Stats.59.51 and are exercised through the resolutions and ordinances it adopts. The Board acts similarly to the state legislature in that it is a policy-making body of the County government. It establishes County ordinances, levies taxes, passes laws concerning law enforcement and appropriates money for services. County Board Supervisors are expected to attend all meetings of the County Board and committees, boards and commissions they are appointed to.
