RE: Vote of No Confidence in Chief Luke Ahlschlager

This letter is submitted as a formal statement in a vote of no confidence in Police Chief Luke Ahlschlager. Each sworn officer has indicated their vote in the matter of no confidence on the following page.

This action has not been taken hastily nor without careful consideration. Over the past several years, recurring issues under Chief Ahlschlager's leadership have resulted in serious concerns related to:

1. Leadership and Administrative Judgment – Persistent patterns of decision-making that have diminished officer trust and confidence in command-level direction.
2. Workplace Culture and Morale – A substantial decline in internal morale attributable to inconsistent communication, lack of transparency, and a workplace climate that has left many officers feeling unsupported and undervalued.
3. Operational Effectiveness – Interference, lack of clarity, and inconsistent supervisory direction have impacted daily operations, officer performance, and organizational structure.
4. Professional Standards and Conduct – Conduct and leadership practices that officers believe fall short of the ethical and professional expectations required of a Chief of Police.

These issues, individually and cumulatively, have eroded the credibility of the Chief's leadership and have compromised the confidence of the department's sworn staff. The result has been declining morale, disruption of operational stability, and concerns about the long-term health of the organization and the community we serve.

We respectfully request that the City initiate a full administrative review of Chief Ahlschlager's leadership, conduct, and performance. As part of an investigation, all sworn staff are willing to speak on-the-record with any administrative, legal, and/or other official(s) of the City of La Crescent.

Our priority remains providing high-quality policing services to the residents of La Crescent, and we believe corrective administrative action is necessary to restore trust, transparency, and stability.

We remain committed to cooperating fully and professionally throughout any subsequent review process.
