

Dear CTA Parents, Faculty and Staff:

We want to update you about a news report that was published this morning.

Yesterday law enforcement partners informed CTA school leadership that an anti-semitic threat was made by an individual who has worked as a private security guard at CTA. We were instructed not to communicate while the investigation was active.

As soon as law enforcement determined that a credible anti-semitic threat was made, immediate actions were taken to identify and apprehend the source and nullify the threat.

We remain in close contact with our law enforcement partners who have advised us that there is no current risk to our campus. Security today is being provided by the Columbus Police Department.

We thank local, state, and federal law enforcement officials for their swift and deliberate action and Jewish Columbus for all that they do to keep our school and community safe.
