Upon my arrival, I met Laurie Hughes the director of the museum. Ms. Hughes informed me that they had recovered a suspicious flyer attached the electronic sign at the entrance to the museum. Ms. Hughes reported that an employee, Wesley Bane, found the flyer on the electronic sign near the entrance.
