

Residents of Half Moon Bay seeking relief from the ongoing trash strike can drop off up to two bags of waste at 110 Higgins Canyon Rd. until 5 p.m. today. The site will not accept recycling or compost materials.

Republic Services customer service also said that residents can dispose of household trash for free at Ox Mountain Landfill, located at 12310 San Mateo Rd. in Half Moon Bay. The landfill is open Monday through Saturday from 8 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. Residents must show proof of a Republic Services account to qualify for free drop-off.

For recycling, Shoreway Environmental Center at 333 Shoreway Rd. in San Carlos continues to accept free drop-offs from San Mateo County residents between 8 a.m. and 5 p.m. daily. Due to high volumes, the facility temporarily paused trash drop-off services at the transfer station.

Another option is the Blue Line Transfer Station at 500 East Jamie Court in South San Francisco, which remains open for household trash, recycling, and green waste. The facility charges by weight, with a minimum fee of approximately \$38 for small loads.
