This year's improvements include continued upgrades to the classroom, outer buildings and learning material. And back by popular demand are the electric powered cars that your child will learn how to drive.

During our Friendly Town week, many topics will be discussed such as Pedestrian Safety, Fire Safety, Stranger Danger, Cyber Safety and Bullying. Danville Police Division School Resource Officers will be assigned to conduct the classes, helping to provide a variety of personality and experience to this fun and interactive program. You child will have the opportunity to practice calling 911, using a simulated city to experience "driving" with traffic controls, and interacting with other First Responders. Upon completion of the course, certificates will be awarded to each child.

The Friendly Town program consists of 5 days of instructions for 2 ½ hours each day. There will be a morning session from 8:30-11:00 and an afternoon session from 1:00-3:30 pm. The program is open to any child currently enrolling in the 1st, 2nd or 3rd grade. This program is completely **FREE!!!!!!**
