While some are saying that they were not aware of my resignation, I want it to be known that I submitted not one but two letters of resignation on Monday 9/30/24. I then submitted a third letter of resignation on Tuesday 10/1/24. I have had several conversations about my resignation with my employers including the reason(s) behind my resignation, could I reconsider and my final date of employment. I also offered to help with the transition process as I hand over my duties to Sgt. Francis Petrovich.

I also communicated with the officers and the sergeant, informing them that I was resigning along with why. Some conversations were in person at the station and some were via telephone call. However, all of the officers and the sergeant were sent a farewell and thank you email.

I would like to thank the entire Snyder County for the opportunity afforded to me during the last two years. Through this experience, we were able to meet many accomplishments despite moments of conflict and adversity. I wish nothing but the best for the officers, Sgt. My last official day with the Selinsgrove Borough Police Department will be Friday October 11, 2024.
