

Pacific Islands Investment Forum (PIIF) – 2026 CEO Forum

Port Vila, Vanuatu | 5–7 May 2026

The Forum will conclude on Thursday, 7 May 2026, with Vanuatu Investment Opportunities Day. Participants will receive briefings on investing in Vanuatu and take part in guided site visits to priority projects and investment opportunities, showcasing the country's potential as a destination for long-term institutional investment.

The PIIF CEO Forum plays an important role in strengthening long-term investment outcomes for Vanuatu and the wider Pacific region by fostering collaboration among regional superannuation and provident funds, development partners, and institutional investors. By aligning capital with sustainable development priorities, promoting strong governance, and sharing best-practice investment strategies, the Forum helps unlock scalable, locally grounded investment opportunities that support economic resilience, infrastructure development, and inclusive growth. Hosting the 2026 PIIF CEO Forum positions Vanuatu as a key investment destination and reinforces the Pacific region's collective capacity to mobilise capital for sustainable, future-focused development.



The Vanuatu National Provident Fund (VNPF) will host the Pacific Islands Investment Forum (PIIF) – 2026 CEO Forum in Port Vila from 5 to 7 May 2026, bringing together chief executives and senior delegates from PIIF member funds and partner institutions across the Pacific region.

The three-day forum will focus on strategic dialogue,

operational best-practice sharing, and investment-focused engagement. It will provide a collaborative platform for senior leaders to discuss regional priorities, emerging challenges, and opportunities for sustainable growth across the Pacific.

The program will commence on Tuesday, 5 May 2026, with the official opening of the

Forum. The opening session will feature a welcome address by the Honorable Johnny Koanapo Rasou, MP, Vanuatu Deputy Prime Minister and Minister of Finance, Economic and Management. The day will include a keynote address presenting United Nations Sustainable Development Goals perspectives and discussions on sustainable development, a Women in

Superpanel addressing gender diversity and leadership, and a performance benchmarking presentation highlighting regional fund performance trends. Sessions on strategic pay and remuneration and the role of artificial intelligence in the Pacific will also be delivered, alongside the PIIF Annual General Meeting.

On Wednesday, 6 May

2026, the Forum will focus on operational excellence and best practices. This day will feature the official launch of a unit trust, a governance workshop examining board dynamics and effective oversight, and a risk management session addressing key regional and institutional challenges facing member funds.
