

The World Health Organization - Country Liaison Office, Vanuatu Special Services Agreement (SSA): Health Promotion Officer

The World Health Organization (WHO) invites applications for qualified individuals to serve as Health Promotion Officer at the Ministry of Health in Vanuatu for health promotion, primary health care (PHC) and risk communication and community engagement (RCCE). The successful applicant will be based at the Health Promotion Unit (HPU) in the Ministry of Health of Vanuatu and is accountable to the WHO Country Liaison Office (CLO) Vanuatu, based in Port Vila.

Background:

The COVID-19 pandemic has significantly affected the unreached and vulnerable population globally. Similar to other Pacific Islands, the pandemic has placed an extra burden on delivering essential health care in Vanuatu, which consists of 83 islands with scattered communities and geographical isolation. Under the prolonged crisis, transparent risk communication and public awareness of health have been highlighted not only to respond to emergencies but also to improve the access to quality health services.

To this end, WHO aims to provide support to the Ministry of Health in strengthening their leadership role in health promotion, PHC and RCCE at the provincial level. The selected candidate will be expected to work directly with the Ministry of Health to design and implement health promotion activities and RCCE in alignment with the PHC concept.

Job description:

- 1. Plan, implement and coordinate the health promotion activities and RCCE in the event of health emergency in the Shefa province
- Supervise and coordinate the PHC activities and the Healthy Islands Policy concept by working closely with the directorate of Public Health and HPU

- Support with management of donor funding resources
 Monitor the Shefa health community studies and conduct a knowledge, attitude
- and practice (KAP) survey
- 11. Assist in coordinating the Shefa Provincial Health Radio Talk
- 12. Assist provincial health officers in various areas; HIV, vector-borne diseases, reproductive health, communicable diseases, non-communicable diseases, nutrition, etc.
- 13. Assist in other health emergencies such as natural disaster situations
- 14. Other related issues as assigned by the supervisors

Subject to the agreement of both parties (WHO and the Ministry of Health) these terms of reference may be modified from time to time, as required in the interest of the activity.

The signatory will primarily work under the direction of the Manager, Health Promotion Unit and WHO staff.

Qualification required:

Diploma of Vanuatu School of Nursing Certificate in Post Public Health Nursing will be a desirable

Experience required:

At least 10 years in the health promotion field

Skills / Technical skills and knowledge:

Driving licence including boat licence is an asset Computer skills (e.g. MS Word, MS Excel) are advantages

Language requirements:

Fluent in English or French and Bislama
