Athens Utilities Board is requesting Bids for the construction of the following Project:

HOLIDAY DR 12" WATER MAIN RELOCATION

Bids for the construction of the Project will be received at AUB's main office located at 100 New Englewood Road, until **July 9, 2026 at 10:00 A.M.** local time, where the Bids received will be publicly opened and read.

The Project includes the following Work:

Construction of 533 ft. of 12-inch dia. D.I. water line near Holiday Drive in Athens, TN. New line is to be constructed closer to property line and replaces existing 12-inch" D.I. water line in the middle of the lot. Existing line to be retired in place. Work includes 533 ft. of 12" D.I.P., associated restrained joints, blocking, testing, disinfection, and the reconnection to existing line.

The Project has an expected duration of 45 days.

Electronic copies of the Bidding Documents for bidding purposes are in PDF format and will be emailed upon request at no charge. Hard copies of the Documents may be obtained at AUB's main office or by overnight delivery at a cost of \$100 for each set. Make checks payable to AUB. There will be no refunds. Upon receipt of payment, shipment will be via overnight delivery service – two-day delivery. Street address must be provided to allow delivery.

All Bidders must register with AUB as a plan holder. Neither Owner nor Engineer will be responsible for Bidding Documents, including addenda, if any, obtained from sources other than AUB.

No pre-bid conference will be held.

For further requirements regarding bid submittal, qualifications, procedures, and contract award, refer to the Instructions to Bidders that are included in the Bidding Documents.

The Owner reserves the right to waive any informalities or to reject any or all bids.

Each bidder must deposit with his bid, a 5% Bid Bond, in the form and subject to the conditions provided in the Information for Bidders.

All bidders must be licensed General Contractors as required by the Contractor's Licensing Act of 1994, as amended, of the General Assembly of the State of Tennessee, and qualified for the type of construction being bid upon.

No bidder may withdraw his bid within 60 days after the actual date of the opening thereof.
