Pursuant to Section 67-5-508, Tennessee Code Annotated, the property Assessment records of Meigs County will be available for public inspection at the Assessor's office at the Meigs County Courthouse during normal business hours. Any person desiring to inspect these records may do so at the appointed time and place.

The Meigs County Board of Equalization began its annual session to examine and equalize the county assessments on June 1st, 2016. **THE BOARD WILL ACCEPT APPEALS FOR TAX YEAR 2016 UNTIL THE LAST DAY OF ITS 2016 REGULAR SESSION, WHICH WILL BE JUNE 29th, 2016.** The board will meet June 29, 2016 from the hours of 9:00 a.m. to 12:30 p.m. in the Assessor's office. Any owner of property who wishes to make a complaint or appeal to the County Board of Equalization must appear before said Board at this time personally or by personal appearance of an agent for the owner bearing the owner's written authorization. Failure to appear and appeal an assessment will result in the assessment becoming final without further right of appeal.
