

NOTIFICATION OF INTENT TO APPLY FOR A CERTIFICATE OF NEED

This is to provide official notice to the Health Facilities Commission and all interested parties, in accordance with T.C.A. §68-11-1601 et seq., and the Rules of the Health Facilities Commission, that KYNGDOM INSPIRATIONS, LLC, a proposed Home Care Organization owned by Sharon Tooley with an ownership type of Limited Liability Company (LLC) and to be managed internally by KYNGDOM INSPIRATIONS, LLC, intends to file an application for a Certificate of Need for the establishment of a Home Care Organization to provide licensed Home Health Services in Tennessee, including skilled nursing, physical therapy, occupational therapy, speech therapy, medical social work, wound care, chronic disease management, IV therapy, pain management, and medication administration and management. The project involves initiating home health services for patients requiring skilled care, rehabilitation, and support to maintain health and independence in their residence. The total estimated project cost is \$69,035.

The anticipated date of filing the application is December 9, 2025.

(A) Any healthcare institution wishing to oppose a Certificate of Need application must file a written notice with the Health Facilities Commission no later than fifteen (15) days before the regularly scheduled Health Facilities Commission meeting at which the application is originally scheduled; and (B) Any other person wishing to oppose the application may file a written objection with the Health Facilities Commission at or prior to the consideration of the application by the Commission, or may appear in person to express opposition.
