#### **City of Etowah – Interior Renovation of the Historic Etowah Carnegie Library**

The City of Etowah proposes an interior renovation of the lower level of the Historic Etowah Carnegie Library to create a functional and welcoming space for community use. The project will transform the lower level into a flexible environment that supports a wide range of public activities and gatherings.

The scope of work includes construction of a large multipurpose room, a kitchenette, new restrooms, and four office spaces. The improvements are intended to support community services, meetings, and small group functions while enhancing the usability of the historic facility.
