ORDER FOR SERVICE BY PUBLICATION

Failing to appear for the hearing on this date and time, without good cause, pursuant to the Tennessee Rules of Civil Procedure, will result in the loss of your right to contest the petition. You may view and obtain a copy of the Petition and any other subsequently filed legal documents at the McMinn County Juvenile Court Clerk's Office.
