Attention Candidates: Display of campaign posters, signs, hats or other campaign materials, distribution of campaign materials and solicitation of voters is **strictly prohibited** within the 100 feet of any polling location. **During the hours the polls are open, candidates are not to enter a polling place unless to cast their vote.**
