

PUBLIC NOTICE OF APPLICATION TO APPROPRIATE PUBLIC WATERS

That Central Washington University, Capital Planning & Projects of Ellensburg, Washington on June 13, 2025, under Water Right Application No. G4-36228, filed for a permit to appropriate public groundwater, subject to existing rights, from up to six wells in eight locations for yearround use in the amount of 13,500 gallons per minute (gpm) and 21,784 acre-feet per year (acft/yr) for industrial (heat exchange) supply purposes.

The sources of the proposed appropriation are located within E $\frac{1}{2}$ of Section 35, Township 18 N., Range 18 E.W.M., and within the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 2, Township 17 N., Range 18 E.W.M., and within Section 36, Township 18 N., Range 18 E.W.M., all within Kittitas County. The proposed place of use is located within E $\frac{1}{2}$ of Section 35, Township 18 N., Range 18 E.W.M., the W $\frac{1}{2}$ of Section 36, Township 18 N., Range 18 E.W.M., the N $\frac{1}{2}$ of Section 36, Township 18 N., Range 18 E.W.M., and the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 2, Township 17 N., Range 18 E.W.M, all within Kittitas County.
