Sealed bids will be received by the City of Ellensburg at the office of the City Clerk at City Hall, 501 N Anderson St, Ellensburg, WA 98926, until **3:00 PM on Thursday, May 21st, 2026**, and will then and there be opened and read for construction of the improvements. Each bid shall be plainly marked **“Feeder 7 Construction and Feeder 1 Line Extension – Bid Call #: 2026-02”**. All bid proposals shall be accompanied by a bid proposal deposit in a cashier’s check or surety bond in an amount equal to five percent (5%) of the amount of such bid proposal. Should the successful bidder fail to enter into such contract and furnish satisfactory performance bond within the time stated in the specifications, the bid proposal deposit shall be forfeited to the City of Ellensburg. The engineer’s estimate for the project is \$1,500,600 to \$1,658,600, including tax.

The purpose of this call for bids and specifications is to obtain a contractor to provide labor, supervision, equipment and materials, where specified, for the construction of a new Feeder 7 and a three phase line extension to existing Feeder 1. The work will include overhead and underground line work, excavation, backfill and restoration, and duct and vault installation. This will provide service to a large commercial distribution warehouse in the City of Ellensburg.

The Contractor must be qualified as stated in Division 2 Section 2.3 in order to be eligible to bid on this project. City provided materials are identified in Division 2 Section 2.14.

The City of Ellensburg, Washington, reserves the right to reject any or all bids and to waive irregularities or informalities in the bid or in the bidding. Responsibility and competency of bidders and their subcontractors will be considered in making the award. All documents received in response to this invitation to bid will become a matter of public record subject to the Washington public disclosure act under chapter 42.56 RCW.

The City of Ellensburg, in accordance with Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964, (78 Stat. 252, 42 U.S.C. 2000d to 2000d-4) and the Regulations, hereby notifies all bidders that it will affirmatively ensure that in any contract entered into pursuant to this advertisement, disadvantaged business enterprises will be afforded full and fair opportunity to submit bids in response to this invitation and will not be discriminated against on the grounds of race, color, or national origin in consideration for an award.

No bidder may withdraw their bid after the hour set for the opening thereof or before the award of contract, unless said award is delayed for a period exceeding sixty days.
