Private, non-profit schools, including non-profit home schools that may have students that reside within Center Point ISD boundaries interested in learning more about federally funded programs and services provided by the Local Education Agency (LEA) are invited to contact the school district for more information.

Federal program services available to eligible private school students, parents/guardians and teachers are: Individuals with Disabilities Education Act, Part B (IDEA-B); IDEA-B Preschool Program; Title 1, Part A Improving the Academic Achievement of the Disadvantaged; Title 1, Part C, Migrant Education Program; Title 2, Part A, Teacher and Principal Training and Recruiting Fund; and Title 3, English Language Acquisition, Language Enhancement & Academic Achievement Act; Title 4, Part A, Student Support and Academic Enrichment Programs.
