

NON-PUBLIC SCHOOLS NOTIFICATION OF SERVICES:

The Every Student Succeeds Act of 2015 (ESSA) stipulates that eligible students enrolled in private, non-profit schools may receive educational support through federally-funded programs and services.

Federal program services available to eligible private school students, parents and teachers are: Title I, Part A Improving Basic Programs; Title I, Part C Education of Migratory Children; Title II, Part A Supporting Effective Instruction; Title III, Part A English Language Acquisition/Enhancement/Academic Achievement for English Learners; Title III, Part A Immigrant Students; Title IV, Part A Student Support and Academic Enrichment; and IDEA-B Individuals with Disabilities Education Act.

Private, non-profit schools that elect to receive services must comply with all requisite federal policies and procedures. Services are coordinated through local education agencies.
