Mojave Gunnery Range "C" Formerly Used Defense Site Restoration Advisory Board

The Mojave Gunnery Range "C" Formerly Used Defense Site (FUDS) is located near California City, California. Today, the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers (USACE) continues to investigate and monitor the site under the Defense Environmental Restoration Program for hazards, such as military munitions, that may remain from previous military activities.

The Department of Defense encourages community involvement in the remediation process. A Restoration Advisory Board (RAB) is one method USACE may use to facilitate public participation at FUDS. RABs provide a collaborative forum for landowners, community members, government agencies, and other interested parties to discuss and identify the most efficient and productive means to remediate the area. Board members are asked to meet regularly to review and comment on technical documents and plans relating to the ongoing investigation and monitoring and remediation activities.
