SUMMARY

At approximately 0700 hours P-1 was traveling westbound in the #2 traffic lane on SR-58 just west of Borax Rd. P-2 was stopped for traffic (due to an unrelated traffic collision in front of them) in the #2 traffic lane of SR-58 just west of Borax Rd. For an unknown reason P-1 failed to stop and struck the rear bumper/trunk area of V-2 causing it to veer off the paved roadway, onto the north dirt shoulder. V-1 continued in a northerly direction through the perimeter fence coming to rest in the desert area on its left side. Both parties of V-2 sustained fatal injuries. Drugs and/or alcohol due not appear to be a factor in this collision. Investigation is ongoing.
