### ORDER

The defendant was arrested on May 2 and 9, 2016 on charges of Receive Stolen Property 4 counts, Theft 2 counts, Forgery and Fraudulent Use of Credit Card. Bail conditions were imposed by the court following the defendant's arraignments on May 3 and 10, 2016. These conditions were:

Defendant's release is subject to the conditions that: defendant not commit a federal, state or local crime while on release; defendant appear at all court proceedings as ordered; defendant advise the court in writing of all changes of address within 24 hours. The defendant shall refrain from possessing a firearm, destructive device, dangerous weapon, or ammunition. The defendant shall refrain from excessive use of alcohol, and use of a narcotic drug or controlled substance as defined in RSA 318-B.

On June 9, 2016, the Manchester Police Department arrested the defendant for a violation of bail conditions and additionally charged the defendant with Sale of a Controlled Drug, Reckless Conduct 4 counts, and Felon in Possession of a Firearm. A Motion to Revoke Bail was filed with the Court on June 10, 2016. A hearing was held on this Motion on June 13, 2016.


At the hearing, the State presented evidence from 2 police officers. The defendant was observed selling a narcotic drug to a confidential informant. There is a video of the defendant firing a 9 mm handgun at an apartment on West Street. 3 projectiles penetrated an apartment. The defendant was a convicted felon.

The Court finds that there is clear and convincing evidence to believe that the defendant has violated his bail conditions. Further, there is probable cause to believe that he has committed the crimes of Sale of a Controlled Drug, Reckless Conduct felony and Felon in Possession of a Firearm.

Pursuant to RSA 597:7-a, the Court must now assess whether there is any condition or combination of conditions of release that will assure that the defendant in this case does not pose a danger to the safety of others. Based upon all the circumstances presented by this situation, this Court finds that no condition or set of conditions will protect the safety of the public. Consequently, the defendant is ordered held WITHOUT BAIL on docket number 2016-CR-2258, 2016-CR-2420, 2016-CR-2261. Bail on the new charges (2016-CR-3073, 2016-CR-3075, 2016-CR-3091) is set in the amount of \$250,000.00 cash with the attached conditions.
