#### CRAB CASSEROLE

3 green onions, chopped

⅓ cup mayonnaise

¼ cup sour cream

4 oz. cream cheese, softened

1 cup shredded Swiss cheese

1 teaspoon garlic powder

l teaspoon mustard powder

1 teaspoon salt

½ cup shredded cheddar cheese for topping

Preheat oven to 350 degrees F.

¼ tsp. Worcestershire sauce


1/8 tsp. garlic powder

I "borrowed" the black top hat from a cheap small plastic snowman ornament I had. I didn't do this, but you could roll each cheeseball in coconut to create an even "snowier" looking snowball cheeseball.

Note: You can make an even taller snowman by creating 3 or 4 "snowballs" and then stacking them on top of each other!



#### **PUMPKIN TRUFFLES**

2 cups white chocolate chips 8 oz. cream cheese (room temperature) 1 cup powdered sugar

½ cup pumpkin puree

l teaspoon pumpkin pie spice

1 teaspoon vanilla

1 sleeve crushed graham crackers

11/2 cups white candy melts

Prepare a cookie sheet with parchment paper.

In a microwave-safe bowl, add the chocolate chips and microwave on 50% power for 1 minute. Stir and microwave for another 30 seconds. When done, stir until smooth and set aside.

In a large mixing bowl, cream together the cream cheese and powdered sugar until smooth.

Add in the pumpkin puree, pumpkin pie spice and vanilla. Mix until fully combined. Add the melted chocolate and graham crackers and mix until smooth. Place in the refrigerator to chill for an hour.

Use a 1-inch cookie scoop and scoop the chilled mixture and roll into 1 to 1½ inch balls. Place each ball on the prepared cookie sheet and chill an additional hour.

Next, melt the white candy melts over a double boiler. Add I tablespoon of Crisco and stir until smooth and silky. Remove from heat.

Using a dipping fork, dip each ball into the melted candy melts, covering completely and place on cookie sheet. Place in refrigerator for 30 minutes.

Repeat the double boiler process for the orange candy melts. Use a piping bag, pipe orange lines back and forth over the truffles. Chill for additional 30 minutes until candy is set. Enjoy!

In a bowl, combine corn, green beans, soup, sour cream, onion, green bell pepper and cheese.

Place in a 3-quart casserole dish. Crush crackers and toss with melted butter. Sprinkle over vegetable mix. Bake uncovered 35 to 40 minutes.

#### **GINGER CREAM BISCUIT LOG**

600ml Bulla Thickened Cream 60g (1/3 cup) icing sugar 1 teaspoon vanilla extract 2 tablespoons finely chopped glacé ginger 250g packet gingernut biscuits 60ml (4 cup) fresh orange juice 60ml (¼ cup) ginger wine 2 tablespoons caramel topping

Use electric beaters to beat the cream, sugar and vanilla until firm peaks form. Use a large metal spoon to fold in half the chopped ginger.

Spread a little of the ginger cream down the centre of a serving plate to help the biscuits stand up. Crush one of the biscuits and set aside.

Combine the orange juice and ginger wine in a shallow bowl. Dip 1 of the remaining biscuits in the ginger wine mixture. Stand upright on the plate and spread I side with cream. Dip another biscuit in the ginger wine mixture and place alongside the first biscuit and sandwich together. Spread with cream. Continue layering with the cream mixture, wine mixture and remaining biscuits to form a log. Spread remaining cream over the

log. Cover loosely with plastic wrap and place in the fridge for 6 hours to chill.

Drizzle the log with the caramel topping and sprinkle with the remaining chopped ginger and the reserved crushed biscuit.

# Parks & Recreation

**Community Park** is located on East Temple Avenue in Effingham and is 35 acres in size. It has 5 ball diamonds, 2 outdoor basketball courts, an 18-hole disc golf course, 4 tennis courts, an outdoor skating rink, plus playground and picnic areas.

Hendelmeyer Park is located at 1906 S Fourth St. in Effingham. It is a 20-acre park that includes a recreation complex that houses two gyms, two meeting facilities, a kitchen, a facility for theatre production with stage area and the Park District offices. The park includes softball diamonds, tennis courts, playground/picnic areas, and skate park.

**Evergreen Hollow Park** is located at 1110 Pelican St. in Effingham. It has 42 acres. The public swimming pool is located there, as are four tennis courts, lighted baseball/ softball diamonds, flag football and soccer fields, picnic areas, playground area and tree walk.

**Bliss Park** is a cozy block-sized park located at 201 W. Clark Avenue in Effingham. It has a play area, shaded picnic area, two shelters and an outdoor basketball court.

**Harmony Playground** is located at 1301 N. Maple St. in Effingham. and is a new playground that accommodates those with disabilities, to provide all children the same outdoor play opportunities.

Lake Sara, located just five miles northwest of Effingham, is a 650-acre lake that provides 27 beautiful miles of shoreline and one of the finest family recreation facilities in Central Illinois. Among the features are a public beach, cabins, playgrounds, bocce ball court, disc golf course, camping and picnic areas, outdoor workout area, fitness challenge course, half-mile walking trail, four pickleball courts and a volleyball court. 
