





ULTIMATE BACON JAM BURGER

For the Bacon Jam:

12 slices bacon, diced 1 large onion, diced 2 tablespoons balsamic vinegar 1 sprig thyme, leaves stripped Kosher salt and freshly ground pepper

For the Secret Sauce:

l cup ketchup l cup mayonnaise ½ cup relish l tablespoon red wine vinegar l ½ teaspoons Sriracha Kosher salt and freshly ground pepper

For the Burgers:

Vegetable oil, for the grill 2½ pounds ground beef chuck Kosher salt and freshly ground pepper 6 teaspoons Dijon mustard 6 slices American cheese 6 sesame buns, split Sliced kosher dill pickles, for topping

Preparation:

For the bacon jam, cook the bacon in a large skillet over medium heat until crisp, 8 to 10 minutes. Add the onion, cover and cook 10 minutes. Uncover and cook, stirring occasionally, until very soft and golden brown, 10 to 15 minutes more. Add the balsamic vinegar and thyme and season with salt and pepper. Set aside.

For the secret sauce, mix the ingredients together in a small bowl.



For the burgers, preheat a grill to medium-high and brush the grates with vegetable oil. Form the beef into six 1/2-inch-thick patties and season with salt and pepper. Grill 5 minutes; flip and brush with the mustard. Grill 5 minutes more for medium-rare. topping with the cheese during the last minute.

Spread the secret sauce on the bottom buns, then top with the burgers, bacon jam, pickles and top buns.



CRUNCHY SUNFLOWER COLESLAW

Salad

3 cups chopped cabbage
1 cup grated carrots
1/3 cup raisins
1/4 cup red onion, chopped
1/2 cup sunflower seeds
8 slices bacon, cooked and crumbled

Dressing:

½ cup Miracle Whip2 tbsp. sugar2 tbsp. vinegar

Make dressing; set aside.

Pepper


8 oz. sour cream 2 cups crushed corn flakes ½ cup melted margarine

Place thawed hash browns in 9 x 13 baking pan.

Mix together the next 8 ingredients and pour this over the hash browns.

Top with crushed corn flakes then drizzle another ½ cup of melted margarine over this.

Bake uncovered at 350 degrees for 45 minutes.



MEXICAN ROLL-UPS

1 pound hamburger
1 onion
8 oz. sour cream
Small can of diced green chiles
Shredded cheddar cheese
8-oz. pkg of cream cheese
1 packet of taco seasoning
Flour tortillas

Cook hamburger and cut-up onion together. When done, drain grease. Add the taco seasoning & follow directions on back of taco seasoning packet until done, cooking together.

Take taco meat off the stove and add sour cream, cream cheese and green chiles and stir together.

Put some of the mixture onto a flour tortilla, then sprinkle some shredded cheddar cheese on it and roll it up, tucking any of mixture back in as you roll it up. Continue doing this with each flour tortilla until you run out of meat.

Put these in a container and put in refrigerator for a while (I usually do overnight). This makes it much easier to cut into slices the next day.



TRI-COLOR PASTA SALAD

1 pkg. multi-colored pasta
3/4 cup chopped onion
3/4 cup chopped green pepper
3/4 cup chopped red pepper
Cubes of cheddar cheese
Cubes of mozzarella cheese or any white cheese
Salt
Sugar
Roasted Red Pepper or Zesty Italian Dressing
Sweet Balsamic Vinaigrette Dressing
Mullens French Dressing

Cook the pasta noodles in boiling water until tender.

Drain water, run cold water over the noodles, and drain again.

Add onion, green pepper and red pepper.

Add cubes of cheese.


Add Italian Dressing and Sweet Balsamic Vinaigrette Dressing.

Mix all this together and taste.

Add salt and sugar to taste.

If you are a fan of Mullens French Dressing, add some dressing to taste. I think it brings even more flavor to the salad.

Note: The wonderful thing about this salad is that you can personalize it by adding other favorite things to give it even more flavor, such as bits of carrots, celery, olives, tomato, cucumber or different cheeses. STRAWBERRY PIE

1 - 8" or 9" graham cracker crust pie shell

1 quart strawberries (I buy 2 quarts of strawberries to be sure I have enough)

Water

1 cup sugar

3 tablespoons cornstarch

1 container of soft strawberry cream cheese

1 pkg. strawberry Jell-O

8-oz. container of Cool Whip

Get the strawberry cream cheese out of the refrigerator so it has time to soften.

In a sauce pan, simmer 3/3 cup water and 1 cup of cut up strawberries for 3 minutes.

In a bowl, blend together 1 cup sugar, cornstarch and 1/3 cup of water. Once blended, pour this into the saucepan of simmering berries and boil I minute or until thickened. Watch this closely so it doesn't burn onto bottom of pan. Use a saucepan that won't burn things to bottom of it. Remove from stove and add the pkg of strawberry Jell-O. Let cool. Then add the remaining cut-up strawberries, mixing together.

Now the cream cheese should be soft enough to spread on top of the pie shell, covering the bottom and sides of the shell. Do not press very hard, as this will break the graham cracker crust shell. I usually use my finger to



prevent this from happening.

Pour what is in the saucepan into the pie shell. If you feel you need a few more strawberries cut up into it, this is a good time to add those.

Refrigerate overnight.

Serve with Cool Whip on top.

TROPICAL MARGARITA SANGRIA

¼ cup triple sec 1 cup good-quality tequila ¼ cup simple syrup 2 tablespoons freshly squeezed lime juice 750 ml sparkling white wine 12 ounces pineapple juice 2 oranges, sliced thin 1 cup sliced pineapple 2 cups sliced apples

2 limes, sliced thin

In a large pitcher, combine triple sec, tequila, simple syrup, lime juice, pineapple juice and sparkling white wine.

If you need to serve a large crowd, just double or triple the ingredients for a larger batch.

Add the sliced fruit at the top of the large container of sangria when you serve it.

This could be served in a large punch bowl or a gallon- or larger-sized drink dispenser.

Also, if you are not a fan of tequila, a rum or other lighter color alcohol could replace the tequila such as peach vodka. The more fruity flavors you can incorporate, the yummier this could be!

If you prefer this to be a non-alcoholic beverage, replace the alcohol with peach juice or apple juice and/or some other light or yellow or orange-colored fruit juice.

Parks & Recreation

Community Park is located on East Temple Avenue in Effingham and is 35 acres in size. It has 5 ball diamonds, 2 outdoor basketball courts, an 18-hole disc golf course, 4 tennis courts, an outdoor skating rink, plus playground and picnic areas.

Hendelmeyer Park is located at 1906 S Fourth St. in Effingham. It is a 20-acre park that includes a recreation complex that houses two gyms, two meeting facilities, a kitchen, a facility for theatre production with stage area and the Park District offices. The park includes softball diamonds, tennis courts, playground/picnic areas, and skate park.


