

COMMISSIONER ORDINANCE NO. CO-2026-10
(Amending Commissioner Ordinance No. CO 2022-05)
HIGHWAY REFERENCE NO. RI-1

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING
STOP REGULATIONS ON ELKHART COUNTY HIGHWAYS

WHEREAS I.C. 36-1-3-4 and -5 permit an Indiana county all powers granted it by statute and all other powers necessary or desirable in the conduct of its affairs, even though not granted by statute, and the county may exercise any power it has to the extent that the power is not expressly denied by the Indiana Constitution or by statute and is not expressly granted to another entity.

WHEREAS the Board of Commissioners of the County of Elkhart, Indiana, (the "Commissioners") is the county executive and legislative body and is by law authorized to adopt ordinances for the government of the county.

WHEREAS the Elkhart County Highway Department (the "Highway Department") has conducted engineering and traffic investigations regarding the regulations herein, and upon the basis of those investigations recommends that the Commissioners impose the regulations herein.

WHEREAS the Highway Department has consulted with the Elkhart County Sheriffs Office (the "Sheriffs Office") regarding the regulations herein, and the Sheriffs Office has advised the Highway Department that the Sheriffs Office supports enforcement of the regulations herein.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Commissioners that:

1. SCHEDULE AMENDMENT.

The regulations schedule in Ordinance CO 2022-05, as amended by any subsequent ordinances, is amended as described in section 4 herein. Ordinance CO 2022-05, as amended, remains in full force and effect.

2. POSTING OF SIGNS.

The Highway Department is directed to maintain signs on the highways consistent with this ordinance.

3. EFFECTIVE DATE AND SAVINGS CLAUSE.

Subject to publication requirements, this ordinance becomes effective on the date thirty days after its adoption, without affecting penalties for prior violations of any regulations.

4. AMENDMENT TO STOP REGULATIONS SCHEDULE.

The following regulations are removed from the stop regulations schedule:

(B) *Other stop intersections.*

CR 24 stops for CR 3

CR 104 stops for CR 17

CR 104 stops for CR 19

Northridge Drive stops for CR 16

Sylvan Court stops for CR 6

Trenton Lane stops for CR 6

The following regulations are modified in the stop regulations schedule:

(A) *All-way stop intersections.*

"Greenleaf Boulevard, Homeland Road, and Shorelane East" is modified to read "Greenleaf Boulevard and Homeland Road and Shorelane East"

(B) *Other stop intersections.*

"Cobus Oaks Drive stops for CR 6 West" is modified to read "Cobus Oaks Drive stops for CR 6"

"Cobus Woods Court stops for CR 6 West" is modified to read "Cobus Woods Court stops for CR 6"

"CR 8 (southeastbound) stops for CR 8/CR 10" is modified to read "CR 8 (southeastbound, Washington Township) stops for CR 8 (Washington Township)/CR 10 (Washington Township)"

"CR 101 stops for CR 6 West" is modified to read "CR 101 stops for CR 6"

"Dutch Settlement stops for CR 2" is modified to read "Dutch Settlement Drive stops for CR 2"

"North Bend stops for CR 23/Division Street" is modified to read "North Bend Drive stops for CR 23/Division Street"

"North Shore Drive stops for Bell Avenue/North Shore Drive" is modified to read "North Shore Drive (northeastbound) stops for Bell Avenue/North Shore Drive (westbound)"


"Old Farm Road stops for CR 6 West" is modified to read "Old Farm Road stops for CR 6"


"Songbird Way (southbound) stops for CR 8" is modified to read "Songbird Way stops for CR 8"


