

## NOTICE TO TAXPAYERS

The 2nd installment of the 2025-2026 real property tax is due and payable and will be delinquent after October 6, 2025.

Any property owner that has not received a tax notice for the 2025/2026 taxes should contact the Elko County Treasurer.

The Elko County Courthouse has a secure entrance from the courtyard on Court Street. All other entrances are closed. Everyone entering the building must pass through security screening. If you prefer not to come through security, you may use the drop box located in the parking lot on Court Street behind the Courthouse. Payments may also be made through your bank's bill pay service or online at <a href="https://www.elkocountynv.net">www.elkocountynv.net</a> (convenience fee will apply)

A 4% penalty will be applied if any one installment of taxes are not received within 10 days following the due date. A 5% penalty will be applied if two installments of taxes are not received within 10 days following the due date. A 6% penalty will be applied if three installments of taxes are not received within 10 days following the due date. A 7% penalty will be applied if four installments of taxes are not received within 10 days following the due date. Prior year's delinquent property taxes are penalized at 10% annual interest.
