**Name:** Elizabeth Simily

**Reason for Nomination:** Senior captain Elizabeth Simily capped off her four-year high school career with a PR and state consideration time of 26.65 in the 50 freestyle at the MSH-SAA Class 1 Championships. Elizabeth was leadoff leg of the 200 free relay that broke the school record to be the first Borgia girls relay team to score points at state. She swam leadoff in 200 and 400 free relays that won first at AAA championship, with two top-six finishes in the 50 and 100 freestyle. Both were PRs. Elizabeth has been a great team leader and a young woman who shines in her faith and in the classroom.

**Reason for Nomination:** Senior Todd Bieg has been the centerpiece of our defense for the past two years. His ability as a rim protector and shot blocker has helped his team as one of the top defenses in the area. However, his 6-7 frame has also been a force on the offensive end with sweet post moves and monster slam dunks. This year, Todd is averaging 10 points a game and 6.5 rebounds with 2 blocks per game. He was named all-district first team and helped the Jays win their ninth district title in school history with a win over Columbia Rock Bridge, 66-53.
