Reason for Nomination: Ryan ended the season on a high note, helping the Washington Blue Jays finish 18-9, the first winning record in six years. In his final two games, he had double-doubles in both scoring and rebounds. In the first round of Class 4 District 4 playoffs Ryan had 18 points and 10 rebounds, helping the Blue Jays win 51-36.
