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- Total Visitor Days- The project will result in 66,000 visitor days in the region. This figure is product of the number of non-local visitors and the length of stay in terms of number of days.
- Total Spending The visitors associated with this project will spend \$0 in the local economy on food & drink, lodging, local transportation, entertainment and retail. This spending is the primary economic driver behind tourism and will determine the overall magnitude of the economic impacts.
- Employment The project directly and indirectly supports 472 full time equivalent jobs in the local economy. This includes employees at the establishments where visitors make

as well as supported employees at other local businesses. It is important to keep in mind these are annualized employment figures and that large events may generate impacts that concentrated over a relatively short time period and thus appear smaller on an annualized basis.

- Personal Income The project directly and indirectly supports an increase in local payroll or personal income of \$12,070,182 in the local economy.
- Output The project creates an annual economic impact of \$30,112,813. This figure represents total visitor spending as well as increased economic activity at local supplier and consumer businesses that support the hospitality industry.
- The revenue impact details the marginal increase in state and local revenues generated directly and indirectly by the project. Direct revenues include state and local sales and lodging taxes generated by visitor spending. Indirect revenues are generated by supported employees in the hospitality industry and other related supplier and consumer industries. Indirect revenues include property taxes, state and local sales taxes and personal income taxes. These impacts are included in the local and state tax revenue figures on the Impact Summary.
 - Local Tax Revenues The project directly and indirectly supports \$1,516,028 in sales and lodging taxes to the local community each year.
 - State Tax Revenues The project directly and indirectly supports \$1,531,844 in sales and personal income taxes to the state each year.

Economic Impact by Type

The Economic Impact by Type report shows for each year the direct impacts of visitor spending, the supplier impacts which estimate business-to-business purchases that might occur locally as a result of these events and consumer impacts that estimate purchases which might be made by employees of tourism events and their families, as well as employees and families of supported supplier businesses.

For each year of the analysis period, economic impacts can be described in terms of the following variables:

- · Employment tourism events directly and indirectly supports 472 full time equivalent jobs in the local economy. This includes employees at the establishments where visitors make purchases as well as supported employees at other local businesses. It is important to keep in mind that these are annualized employment figures and that large events may generate impacts that are concentrated over a relatively short time period and thus appear smaller on an annualized basis.
- · Personal Income tourism events directly and indirectly supports an increase in local payroll or personal income of \$12,070,182.
- · Output tourism events creates an annual economic impact of \$30,112,813. This figure represents total visitor spending as well as increased economic activity at local supplier and consumer businesses that support the hospitality industry.
