KEY POINTS

- **1,630** cases were reported in the past week
13.9% decrease from the week before (April 11-17)
- **72** deaths were reported in the past week
- **25,877 (5.8%)** cases have been hospitalized
- **3,983,139** specimens have been tested in total
- **2,202,315** vaccine doses have been administered in total
- The average age of cases was **40** years and average age of individuals who died was **75** years
- The youngest case was **less than a year old** and the oldest case was **100+ years**
- The youngest individual to die from COVID-19 was **less than 15 years** and the oldest was **100+ years**
