
## Case Count and Estimated Daily Incidence - Garfield



The above graph displays the number of cases reported for a given county by date. The circles represent the estimated cases per 100,000 population (US Census 2019est) based on a 7 day average. Colors indicate the risk level (extreme risk levels (> 50) are not displayed).

Colors indicate Risk Levels. Details and labels are shown for County.

2. Average days of statewide PPE on hand and available is < 5 days.

3. Percent of ventilators available is <5% statewide.

<sup>\*</sup>If a County resides in a Region that has met one or more of the thresholds listed below that County will be elevated <u>one</u> Risk Level.

<sup>1.</sup> Region has reached maximum hospital capacity (defined as activation of contracted beds pursuant to state hospital surge plan or 100% of the average of licensed and staffed beds) AND at least 50% of contracted hospital beds under surge plan are filled.
