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City of Erie Announces Neighborhood Tree-Limb Removal Schedule Following Severe Storm

ERIE, PA (September 11, 2026) - The City of Erie announced today that the Department of Public Works will follow a neighborhood schedule for tree-limb removal beginning Monday, September 14, as storm cleanup efforts continue throughout the City.

City crews will collect storm-related tree limbs that residents have placed in piles between the curb and sidewalk. Residents are also asked to move vehicles from the street when crews are scheduled to collect in their neighborhood. If vehicles are blocking access to storm debris, crews may be unable to safely complete the collection and the debris may not be collected.

The neighborhood schedule is as follows:

Monday, September 14

West Side: West 12th St. to the lake, between State St. and Weschler Ave.

East Side: East 12th St. to the lake, between State St. and East Ave.

Tuesday, September 15

West Side: West 12th St. to the lake, between Weschler Ave. and Pittsburgh Ave.

East Side: East 12th Street to the lake, between East Avenue and Chautauqua Boulevard

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Wednesday, September 16

West Side: West 12th St. to West 38th St., between State St. and Pittsburgh Ave.

East Side: East 12th St. to East 38th St., between State St. and East Ave.

Thursday, September 17

West Side: West 38th St. to West Grandview Boulevard, between State St. and Greengarden Boulevard

East Side: East 12th St. to East 38th St., between East Ave. and Bird Drive

Friday, September 18

West Side: West 38th St. to West Grandview Boulevard, between Greengarden Boulevard and Pittsburgh Ave.

East Side: East 38th St. to East Grandview Boulevard, between State St. and Bird Drive

The schedule is tentative and may change based on weather conditions, the volume of debris, and operational needs. This collection schedule applies to storm-related debris from residents only. Private contractors are responsible for removing debris generated from their work.

The City thanks residents for their patience and cooperation as crews continue the community-wide storm cleanup effort.
