Established in 1930 by the Western Golf Association and celebrated amateur golfer Charles "Chick" Evans Jr., the Evans Scholars Foundation awards full tuition and housing college scholarships to high-achieving caddies with limited financial means. We are the nation's largest scholarship program for caddies, driving toward a goal of having 1,500 Scholars in school by 2030.

Evans Scholars come from 30 states and Canada, attending 27 leading universities where they live together in Scholarship Houses or campus housing. Our award-winning Program is powered by the generosity of more than 43,500 Par Club donors — many of them proud Alumni — and through proceeds from our tournaments, including the BMW Championship, a PGA TOUR FedExCup Playoff event.
