#### **BACKGROUND**

- Leader in Minor League Baseball Since 1982
- Developed 15 Ballparks for Own Teams and Others
- Owned and Operated Numerous Minor League Teams including Hagerstown Suns, Frederick Keys, Bowie Baysox, and Delmarva Shorebirds
- Peter Kirk chaired governing body of Minor League Baseball
- Consulted with Communities, Major League Baseball and Minor League Teams nationally
- Provided Grounds crews for Sydney Olympics and Orioles Exhibition Game in Havana, Cuba

#### SPOTSYLVANIA INVOLVEMENT

- Initially approached by RBI as part of their due diligence in 2011
- Met with BOS in November, 2014 to Offer Assistance
- Letter of Intent from Spotsylvania with Goals for possible Team/Ballpark November 25, 2014
  - \* Washington Nationals Affiliate
  - \* Maximum County contribution \$25 million
  - \* At least 5,000 seats with state-of-the art amenities multipurpose venue
  - \* Better than average financial deal for County must be fiscally sound
- Worked with Hagerstown Suns to obtain "Permission to Explore" from Baseball
- Reviewed other comparable Ballparks/Teams for County
- Developed Preliminary Ballpark Program Plan and Budget for Spotsylvania Demographics
- Lease negotiated, BUT WITH CONTINGENCIES TO BE WORKED ON BEFORE DEAL IS FINAL

  - \* 16 Luxury Suites (1 Exclusively for County)
- \* Year-Round Restaurant/Club
- \* Combination Splash Pad Ice Rink
- \* Extensive Playground for All Ages
- \* Picnic Decks and Group Hospitality Areas
- \* Designed to Host Concerts, Graduations, Softball, Football, Lacrosse, Soccer, Cricket, Band and Cheerleading Completions, and Much More

## 10 YEARS LATER- OVER \$500 MILLION OF NEW DEVELOPMENT




