

The water from our homes (bathing, laundry, washing) and our businesses (manufacturing processes, etc) leaves warmer than the supply.

Treatment facilities clean the water but it may still be too warm, so it is sent to Talking Water Gardens.

The water is oxygenated, cooled, and naturally treated using a series of waterfalls and weirs.

The water returns to the Willamette River at a temperature able to support the river ecosystem.
