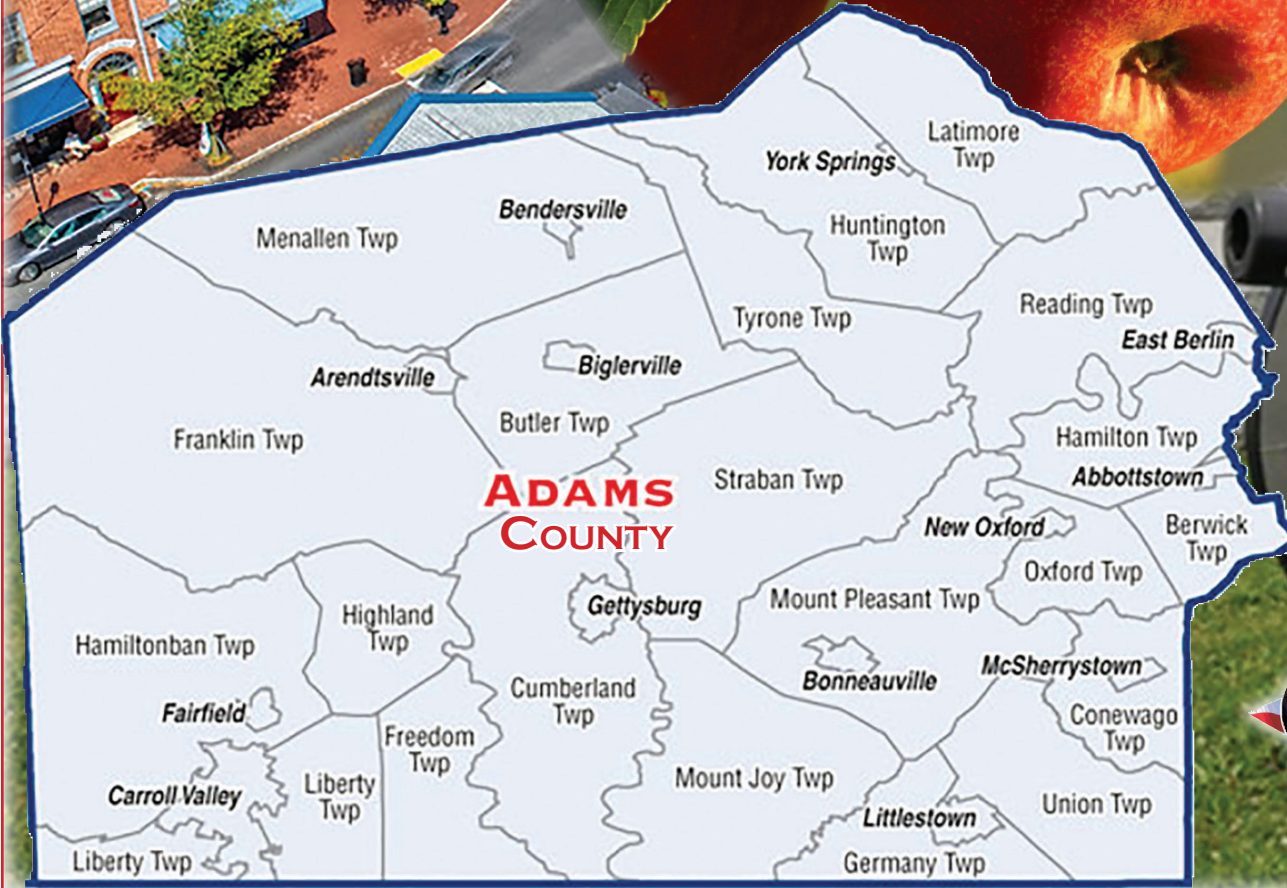

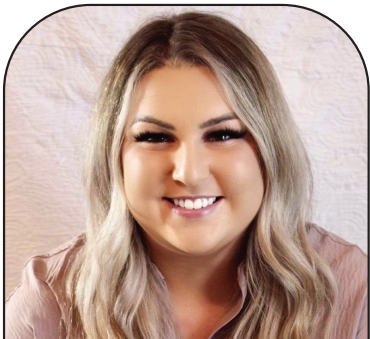

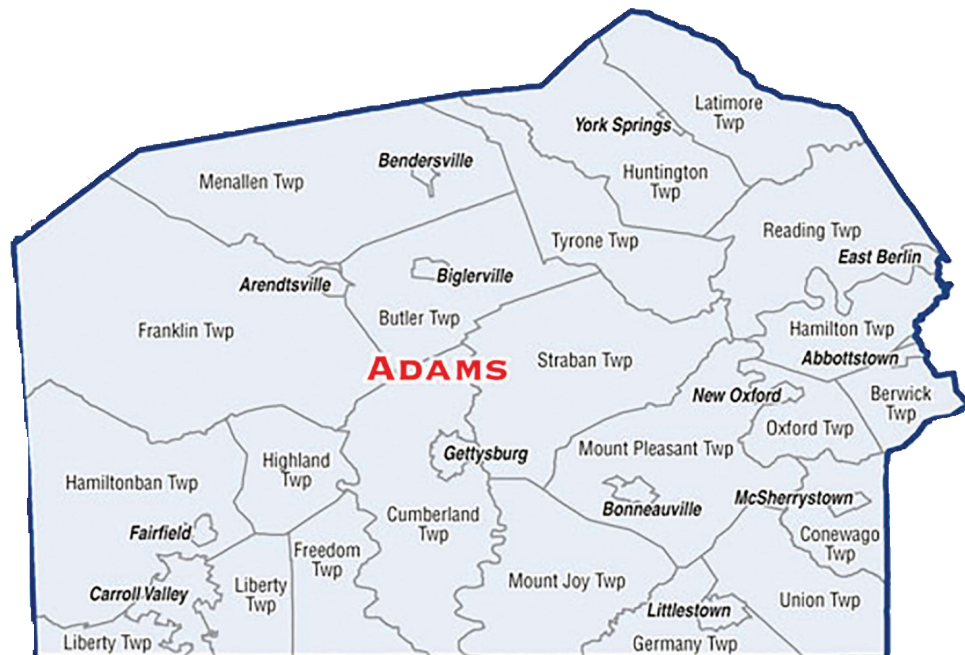

# Adams County, PA



Adams County is situated along the Mason-Dixon line in south-central Pennsylvania. The state capital of Harrisburg is located about 36 miles north of Gettysburg, the county seat. As of the 2022 Census, the population was 103,852. The county was created on January 22, 1800, from part of York County, and was named for the second President of the United States, John Adams. Adams County, carved out of its parent York by the state legislature on January 22, 1800, was the 26th of the commonwealth's 67 counties. With an area of about 521 square miles, it ranks 44th in size. Gettysburg was selected as the county seat.

The separation of Adams County from York County in 1800 followed the same line of divisions in numerous other counties. For many years, residents in what was called the upper end of York County had provided their full weight in political battles and by the late 1700's residents were ready to have their own local representation.

The census of 1800 recorded the population of Adams County to be 13,173, a number which would more than double to 28,006 by 1860.

After the Civil War ended, population growth leveled off. There were moderate gains in the county population beginning in the 1920's. The 1950 census listed 44,197 residents in the county.

During this entire period the number of foreign born averaged less than 2 percent of the total population. In 1800, the number of African Americans in the county was 303, of whom 114 were enslaved.

An act of 1780 provided for the gradual abolition of slavery in Pennsylvania. Only two remained in the county by 1840. The last enslaved person died in 1858. The number of Blacks in the county, which had peaked at 692 in 1840, declined steadily after the Civil War and stood at 267 in 1950.

After 1800 the number of towns and villages increased, but as of 1860 there were only two boroughs (Gettysburg and Abbottstown), only one of which had more than 1,000 people.

By 1950, there were eleven boroughs with Gettysburg the only one with

more than 5,000 people.

During the first half of the twentieth century, Adams County ranked sixth in wheat production within the commonwealth. After about 1900, commercial production of apples, peaches, and later cherries became a major undertaking, especially in a four-to-six-mile belt along the northern and western county boundary. By the 1920s, Adams County ranked first or second in the state in annual production of all three fruits.

After several real or threatened military events in and around Adams County, the Confederate Army of Northern Virginia and the Union Army of the Potomac met in and around Gettysburg at the end of June 1863. Over three days in July an estimated 170,000 soldiers fought each other. When the battle ended, more than 40,000 were among the killed, wounded, or missing. The Confederates retreated and returned to Virginia. Then began the incredibly difficult task of caring for the wounded, burying the dead, destroying horses, removing debris of all kinds, and resuming lives. While this was happening, visitors began coming, looking for loved ones, or simply observing the scene. The newly created Gettysburg Battlefield Memorial Association, Soldiers' National Cemetery was dedicated on November 19, 1863 by President Abraham Lincoln. In 1879 the first of about 1,300 monuments was erected on the battlefield, which eventually became and has remained the most heavily marked such place in the world. Subsequent presidents followed Lincoln to Gettysburg, either to visit or to deliver addresses. In 1895, the property was transferred to the United States War Department. In 1933, it became part of the National Park Service in the Department of the Interior.

A major reunion was held in 1913; it was addressed by both President Woodrow Wilson and Vice President Thomas R. Marshall. The last formal reunion of Blue and Gray was held in 1938, during which President Franklin Roosevelt dedicated the Peace Light Memorial. An estimated 200,000 people attended this reunion, including 1,845 Civil War veterans, most of who had not fought at Gettysburg.

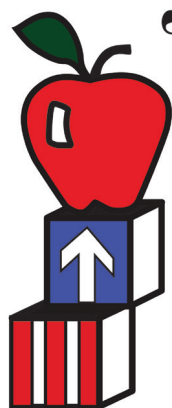

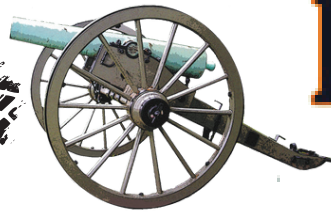
