In our circle of friends, we all know that lifelong couple that have had the perfect marriage for decades and have just received news that one spouse has been diagnosed with early stage dementia, Alzheimer's or Parkinson's. 2. Keep an open line of communication with your doctor. Talk to him about treatment options. Discuss with your spouse the pros and cons to each option.

3. Create a plan. Take into account not only financial

management but also home safety, transportation, healthcare options, estate planning and most importantly your emotional requirements as a caregiver.

4. Find and use local support and resources. Benevilla offers many different caregiver resources. Participate in one of the many free local caregiver support groups. The Gravity of Hearing Loss

One of the greatest fears of aging is the fear of falling. As we age the results of a fall can cause injuries that are either life threatening or life altering and no one wants to deal with these consequences. Falls can occur for a number of reasons. Loss of hearing is one of them. Sometimes loss of hearing can be due to an infection or a build-up of ear wax. These are issues that can be taken care of easily. However, true hearing loss can increase your risk of falling and Impact your balance. Through

a hearing exam, an audiologist can know for sure if hearing loss is the cause of balance issues or if an infection or ear wax build up is to blame.

Loss of hearing can also result in a lack of brain stimulation. There was a 25 year study out of Johns Hopkins University that shows there is a correlation between hearing loss and dementia. It's not so much the loss of hearing noise that is harmful to your brain as much as it is the loss of distinguishing speech. Your brain

needs discernable language to keep your brain functioning.

An annual hearing test starting at the age of 50 is recommended or before this age if you notice you don't understand speech as well as you once did. There have been huge advances in hearing aid technology and it is important to become educated on your options and consult a professional before purchasing.



Are your feet tired or swollen at the end of the day? Do you have spider veins or varicose veins? Has your physician recommended compression stockings to be worn during the

compression stockings work? Let's see if I can help you understand why they work.

Your blood vessels carry blood through your body. The arteries go from the heart to the very small capillaries. At the capillary level the Oxygen and nutrients are exchanged within the tissue (good in and bad out). The return of the blood is achieved through the venous system. The arterial system is dependent on the heart to provide enough pressure to get it to the tips of your toes and fingers. The venous system uses "pressure" valves to move the blood back to the heart. As our body changes throughout our lives the valves in our legs do not close

were young. The inability to close efficiently leads to swelling.

Compression stockings provide pressure to the leg to prevent the swelling. Compression stockings generally are done in light, medium or moderate, and heavy compression levels. Your physician will either tell you the amount of compression or give you a prescription for the amount of compression that you need. The compression is tightest at the ankle to assist the venous system to return the fluid toward the abdomen to allow the fluid to recirculate.

Is My Child Stuttering?

As children develop language skills between two and five years of age, they may experience periods of normal disfluency while speaking, such as repeating whole words or syllables ("Can...can I go?") or inserting fillers ("um"). Disfluencies can fluctuate as children learn new ways of using language, and will typically resolve naturally as children increase their language skills.

Here are some things you can do to help a child who is experiencing disfluencies:

- Use a slow and relaxed speaking rate when talking to your child.
- Give your child time to speak and offer your undivided attention
- Reassure your child



If you have any concerns about your child's language development, a speech-language pathologist can assess your child's abilities and determine whether treatment is indicated.

that you are listening by showing acceptance with your body posture and facial expressions.

- Ask fewer questions and place less demand on your child for speaking performance.
- Focus on giving your child time to talk without interrupting.
- Tell your child that it's okay to have trouble talking sometimes.
- Focus on all the wonderful things your child does that are

unrelated to speak-

Consult a professional if you have questions or if it seems like your child is avoiding talking, struggling to speak, or making sounds that are blocked or prolonged ("ssssssssorry"). A speech-language pathologist can assess whether your child is experiencing typical disfluencies or true stuttering and determine whether treatment is indicated.

From military protocol to traditions and lingo, Heart Link teaches civillian spouses what their military counterparts deal with on a daily basis. Spouses are introduced to the military community. They have an important role to play, which is keeping up the home front while their spouses are deployed and being a source of support for the

Heart Link, which is geared toward newlyweds, is designed to help connect military members with their spouses. By integrating spouses into the military it helps to enhance mission readiness. Participants learn about military protocol and military and Air Force traditions including the role of coining and the Air Force song. Learning these things helps them understand military culture.

Military Family Life Consultants (MFLC) provides short-term, nonmedical counseling to Service Members and their families. MFLCs augment existing military support programs worldwide. 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

Patients praise new Medicare program

It's no secret that people fighting a serious chronic illness are often right on the edge of hospitalization. One fever or one late night fall results in a call to 911. That often leads to an ER visit, a stay in the hospital, and a rehab stint that can last weeks. Then the cycle starts all over again.

That's exactly what Harold Delano was experiencing. It was exhausting, expensive and frustrating. His wife Glennis believed they could prevent these trips to the hospital if someone was checking in on Harold and heading off trouble. She knew there had to be a better way.

Well, now there is. Since January, Medicare has been allowing some patients to continue treatments like dialysis, radiation, chemo, immunotherapy, etc.—and at the same time, have a hospice team come to their home to provide medical, emotional, social and spiritual support. Up until now, Medicare required patients to forego such treatments in order to elect hospice care. Hospice of the Valley is the only agency in Arizona chosen to participate in the program—and so far, patients are singing its praises.

The hospice team not only keeps close watch over the patient, it provides support to the caregiver who is often overwhelmed and lonely.

"She cares about how I'm doing," Glennis said. "I don't get a lot of sleep and sometimes it feels like a losing battle, but I want to keep him at home. We've been married 62 years and we're not about to be separated."

The Rouths have also had a positive experience with Medi*Caring*[®]. Kay claims that 2 weeks after they signed up, the program prevented a trip to the hospital. Her husband Ed had a fever that was rapidly getting worse. Within 2 hours, their hospice nurse contacted his doctor for an antibiotic and by morning, he was much better. 


