AGREEMENT NOT TO PRACTICE

COME NOW the Iowa Board of Physical & Occupational Therapy ("Board") and Samantha Jo Rogers ("Respondent"), 206 Louisiana Ave S, Mason City IA 50401, and enter into the following Agreement Not to Practice ("Agreement"):

- 1. Respondent holds Iowa license number 002405 to practice occupational therapy, which is currently active through February 15, 2020.
- 2. In July 2018, Respondent was arrested and charged with burglary in the third degree, a felony, in Franklin County, Iowa.
- 3. As a result of the pending criminal charge and ongoing criminal investigations, and in order to meet the Board's interest in protecting the public in the absence of a disciplinary proceeding, the parties agree to the following:
 - a. The Board will not pursue public disciplinary charges against Respondent until the pending criminal charges, and all pending criminal investigations and any subsequent criminal charges, are resolved at the district court level.
 - b. Respondent will not practice occupational therapy or engage in any conduct that requires a license to practice occupational therapy in the State of Iowa until all criminal charges and any subsequent Board-issued disciplinary charges against her are resolved through further order of the Board. Respondent understands that this Agreement will result in her license status being changed to "Suspended" until further order of the Board.
 - 4. Respondent is freely and voluntarily entering into this Agreement
- 5. Respondent understands this Agreement, when fully executed, is a public record and is available for inspection and copying in accordance with the requirements of Iowa Code chapters 22 and 272C.
- 6. Respondent understands the Board is required by federal law to report any adverse action to the National Practitioner Data Bank.
- 7. This Agreement is subject to approval by the Board. If the Board does not approve the Agreement, it shall be of no force or effect to either party.

8. Should Respondent violate the terms of this Agreement, the Board may initiate action to impose other Respondent discipline as authorized by Iowa Code chapters 147, 148B, and 272C and 645 IAC chapters 13 and 209.
