ORDER

The plaintiffs' Amended Motion for a Temporary Injunction came before the Court for hearing. The plaintiffs were represented by Roxanne Barton Conlin and Kayla Burkhiser Reynolds and the defendant appeared personally without counsel.

On March 22, 2018, this Court granted the plaintiffs' Petition for a Temporary Injunction which enjoined the defendant from disposing or otherwise encumbering his \$100,000.00 winnings from the Iowa Lottery. The matter was set for hearing on April 23. The matter was continued upon the motion of the plaintiff.

The plaintiffs' petition seeks damages as a result of sexual assault, common law assault and battery, false imprisonment and intentional infliction of emotional distress. The defendant was the subject of prosecution by the State of Iowa on related charges. He ultimately entered a guilty plea and was sentenced. A requirement of his sentence was payment of victim restitution.

The defendant has not filed an answer in this action. He advised the Court the he has been unable to find an attorney, but desires one. The Court informed him that he is in default and the ramifications of a default judgment. The Court also advised the defendant that the Court cannot provide a Court-appointed attorney for him because this is a civil matter.

The defendant's only objection to a continuation of the injunction is a statement that the lottery proceeds have been spent and that he needs to "pay bills."

The Court informed the defendant that the disposition of the lottery proceeds was not before the Court today, nor was the issue of entry of a default judgment.

The Court finds that the plaintiffs are entitled to the entry of a temporary injunction based on the grounds alleged in their May 21, 2018, Amended Motion for a Temporary Injunction.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the temporary injunction entered on March 22, 2018, should continue and that therefore, the defendant, Dean Hilpipre, is hereby enjoined from disposing of or otherwise encumbering in any manner his \$100,000.00 winnings from the lowa Lottery.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that this temporary injunction shall continue until further Order of this Court.
