COMES NOW Andrew D. Olson, as Prosecuting Attorney of Cerro Gordo County, Iowa, and in the name and by the authority of the State of Iowa, accuses JEREMY WALTER ROSE of the crime of: **Child Endangerment Resulting in Serious Injury to a Child or Minor**, committed as follows:

The said **Jeremy Walter Rose**, on or about June 22, 2017, in the County of Cerro Gordo, and State of Iowa, did, being a parent, guardian, or person having custody or control over a child, or a person who is a member of the household in which a child resides, do one or more of the following:


- a. knowingly act in a manner that created a substantial risk to a child's physical, mental or emotional health or safety,
- b. an intentional act or series of intentional acts, using unreasonable force, torture or cruelty that resulted in bodily injury, or that was intended to cause serious injury,
- c. An intentional act or series of intentional acts, evidences unreasonable force, torture or cruelty which caused substantial mental or emotional harm to a child or minor,
- d. Willfully deprive a child of necessary health care or supervision appropriate to the child's age, when Jeremy Walter Rose was reasonably able to make the necessary provisions and which deprivation substantially harmed the child's physical, mental or emotional health, and/or
- e. Knowingly permit the continuing physical or sexual abuse of a child or minor, and such child endangerment resulted in serious injury to a child or minor, and did so as part of the engaging in a course of conduct including three or more acts of child endangerment as defined in Iowa Code Section 726.6 within a period of twelve months involving the same child, where one or more of the acts resulted in serious injury to the child or resulted in a skeletal injury to a child under the age of four years of age, to wit: did commit child endangerment on the following occasions:

- 1) On or about June 10–22, 2017, did cause a cigarette burn and/or bruise(s) to the infant child,
- 2) On or about June 21, 2017, did hold the infant child to his side and was whipping her around in a non-gentle manner, and
- 3) On or about June 22, 2017, did cause serious injury to the child and/or willfully failed to provide the infant child with necessary health care or supervision, which resulted to serious injury to the child,

in violation of Section 726.6(1) and 726.6(5), and 726.6A of the Code of Iowa, a Class B Felony.
