On the afternoon of Friday, February 23, 2018, school officials became aware of a threat made by an individual to the safety of students and staff at the Mason City High School. High school administration contacted the Mason City Police Department via the School Resource Officer and the Mason City Police Department took over the investigation.

The Mason City Police Department and Mason City High School are confident, following thoroughly all steps necessary in this investigation, classes may resume as normal on Monday, February 26, 2018.
