Message of the Day

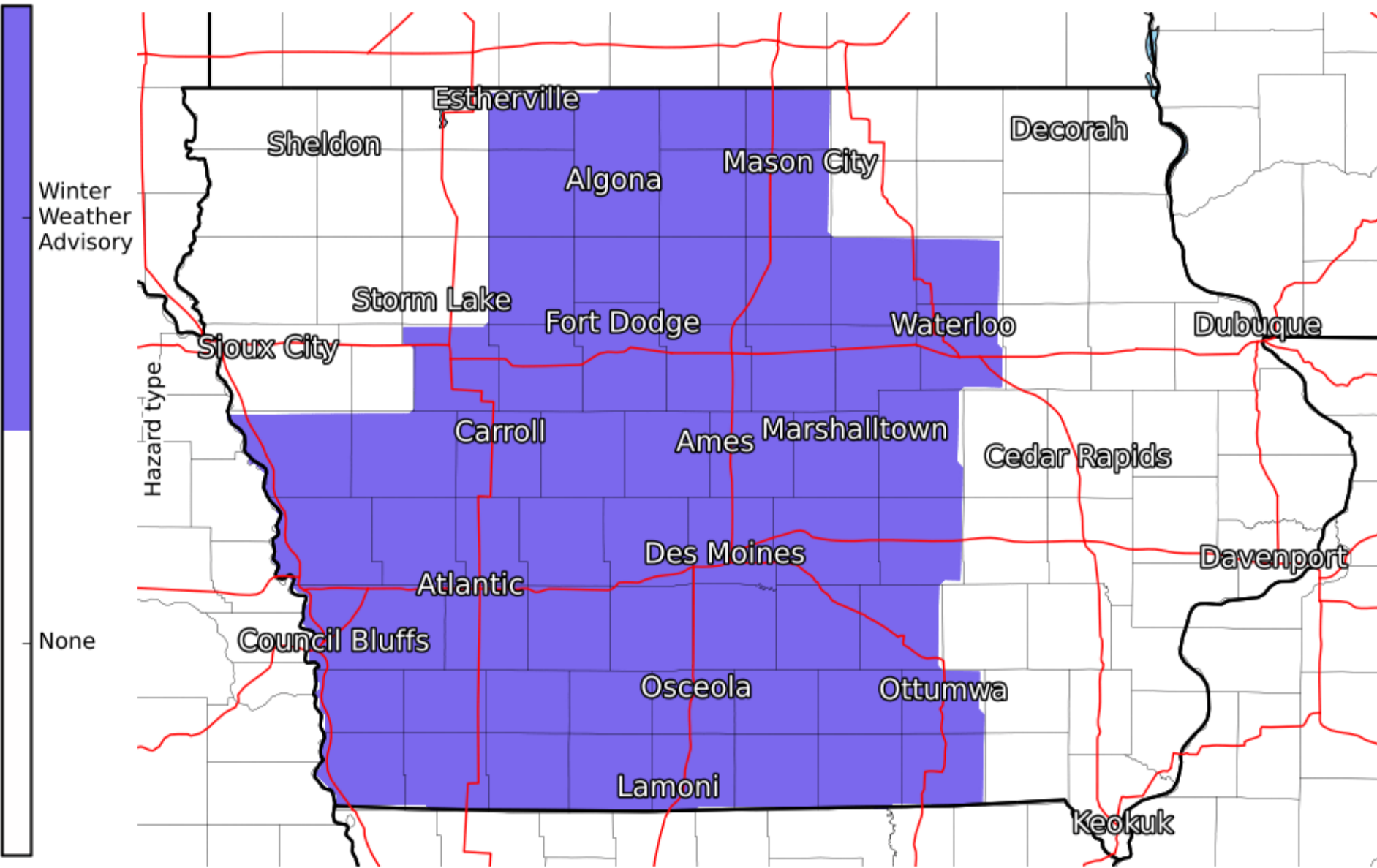
- ✓ Long duration precipitation event beginning late tonight with periods light snow and a wintry mix at times through Friday.
- ✓ Temperatures hovering around freezing through much of the event.
- ✓ Roads and highways becoming snow covered or slushy causing hazardous travel, especially overnight and during commute times. Some melting will occur during the daytime.

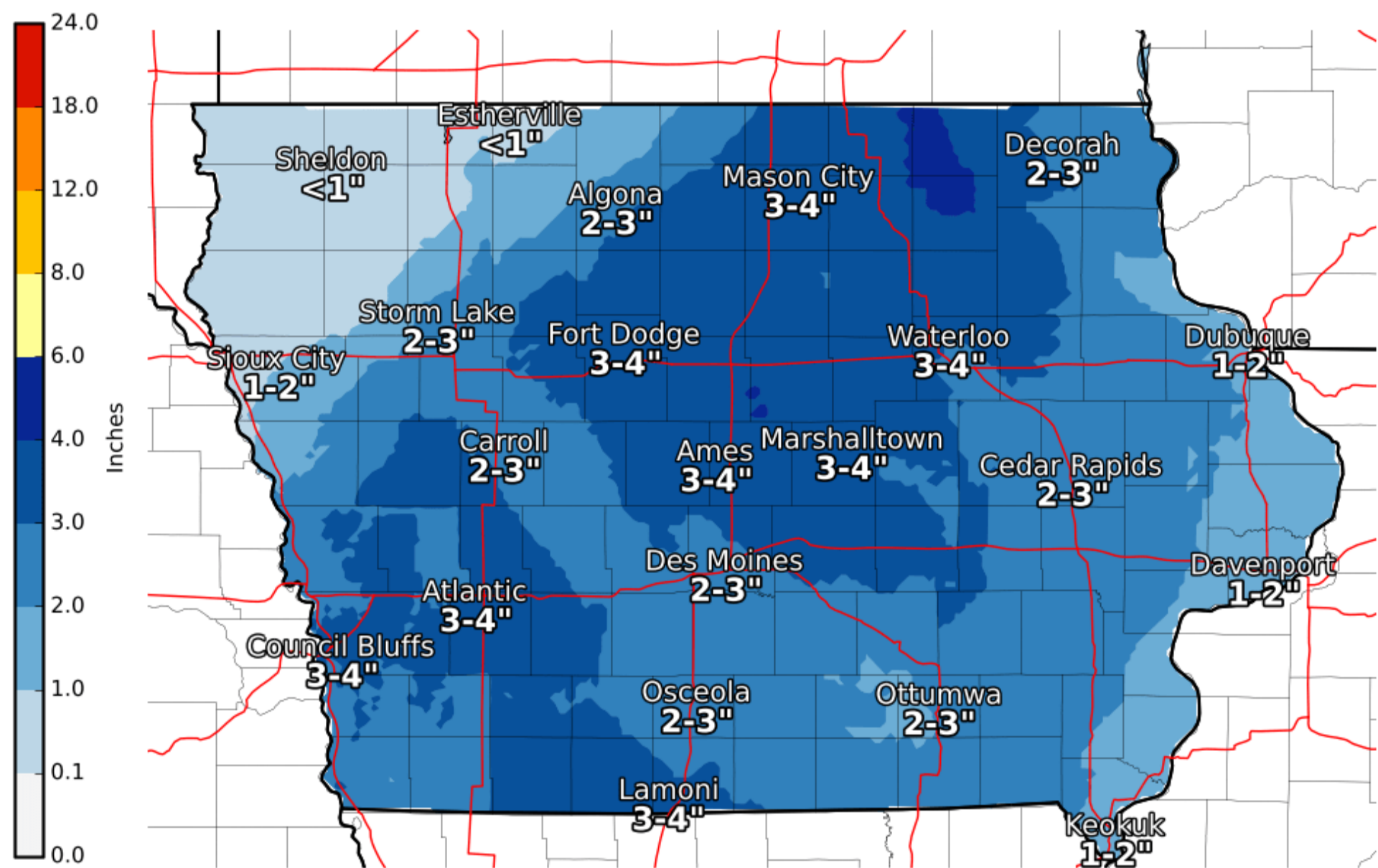

Impacts to the morning and evening commutes are possible. Drivers should remain alert for slick spots!

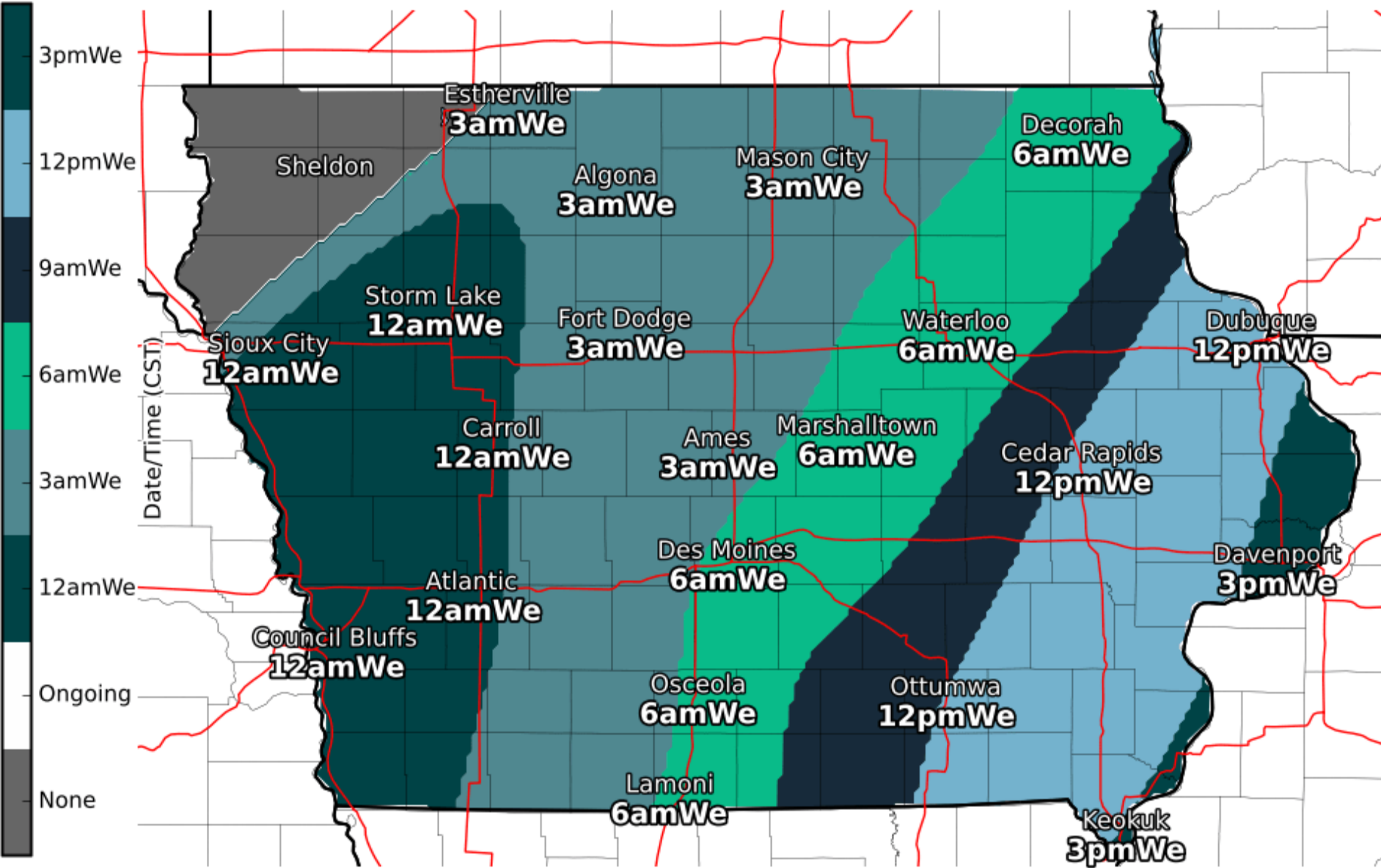

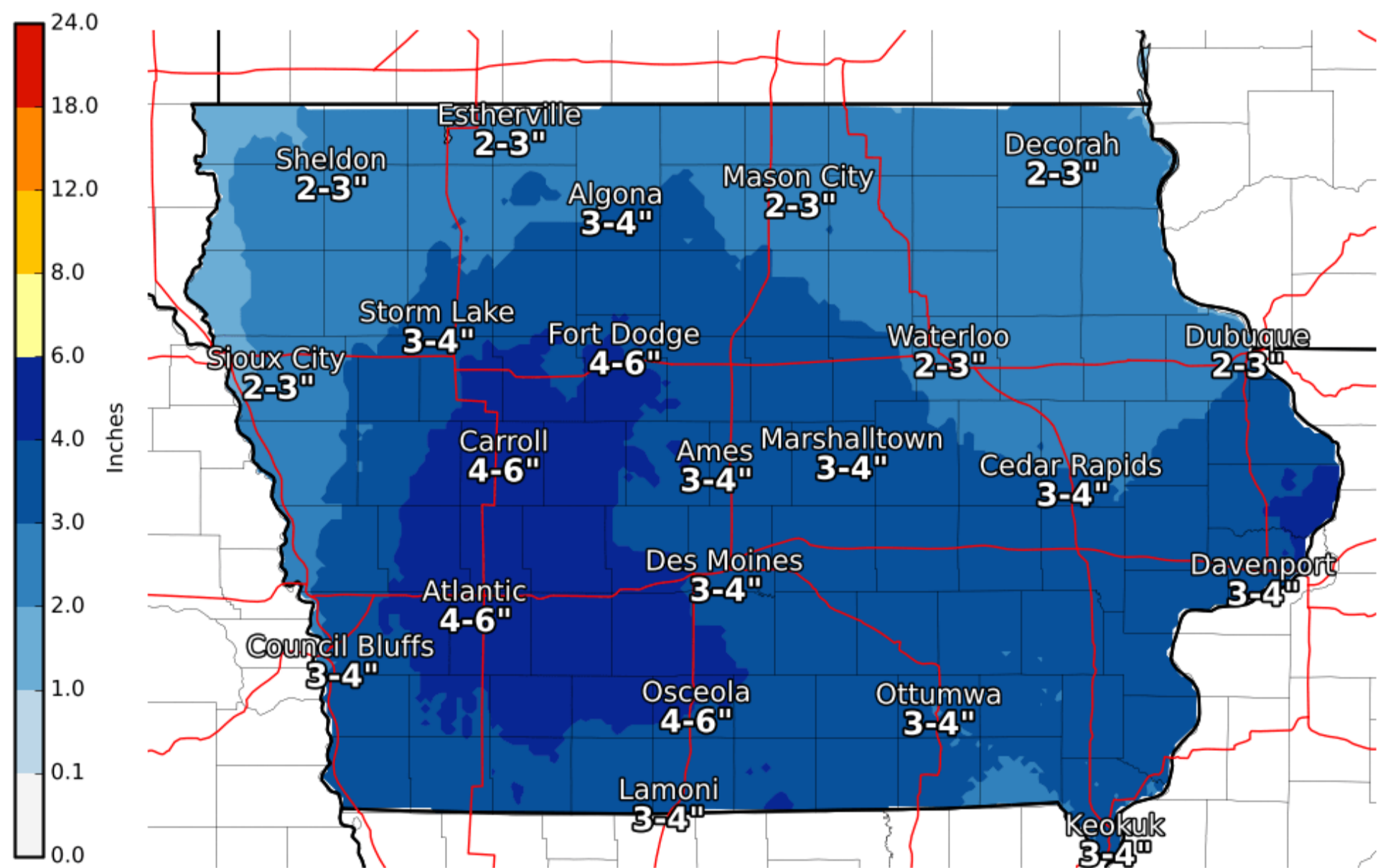

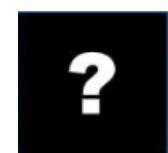
