Dear Mayor Theken:

This is to inform you that Whole Foods Market's North Atlantic Region will be permanently closing its entire Pigeon Cove Seafood Facility located at 15 Parker St., Gloucester, MA 01930 effective August 15, 2019. The closing will impact approximately 59 employees. We can make available to you if needed the job titles of the positions to be affected and the number of affected employees in each job classification. There are no bumping rights available, and no union represents the affected employees.

Whole Foods Market will continue to provide full pay to the affected Team Members through the effective facility closing date to the extent necessary to meet our WARN Notice obligations. During this time, it is Whole Foods Market's intent to work with affected employees to secure other positions within our Whole Foods Market stores and facilities to the extent possible.
